Old Man Winter seems reluctant this year to give us a steady stream of good/warm weather but taking advantage of those warm days in-between, I see the boats are getting

uncovered and we'll all be relaxing in the bays before we know it!

A group hold has been placed for our weekend rendezvous to Kelly's Island the weekend of July 19 -21, and you should receive details separately soon. With that, all of our rendezvous are scheduled for the 2019 season. Note, if you are planning to attend any of these by boat, you'll need to reserve your own slips. Each event has a limited number of slips, with expirations on the group holds (expirations noted in the individual notices). Also...Tickets for the Tigers game in mid-June are being purchased now. If you didn't sign up and decide later that you'd like to attend, please contact me directly.

**Waterway/lake tips...** Boat preparations and early-season boating. Here's a few more that don't necessarily apply to everyone in our club but thought I'd share, just as a reminder. As we unwrap the boats, polish the brightwork and clean out the winter dust, take advantage of the opportunity to check all of your equipment before your maiden voyage. Just because it worked when you put it away in the fall, doesn't guarantee it still works this spring ;). Remember to include your communication and safety gear (including flares, which have expiration dates). A comprehensive checklist is recommended to ensure nothing is forgotten and this will vary by the type of boat and/or power you have.

Making your own list that can be used each year is a good idea to ensure nothing is overlooked. If you don't know where to start, I found a few good options with a quick internet search for "Boat Spring Safety Checklist". Another option is to ask our fellow/senior club members...we have some very experienced boaters among us . One last thought (especially for early in the Michigan boating season), whether you're just working around your docks or heading out for that maiden voyage, let someone know what you're doing and when you'll check in. With water temps currently in the low 40's, should the worst case scenario happen and you end

up in the water, exhaustion and/or unconsciousness can set in, in as little as 30 minutes. Once you are in the water is not eh time to think about who knows where you are. Have fun and stay safe!
