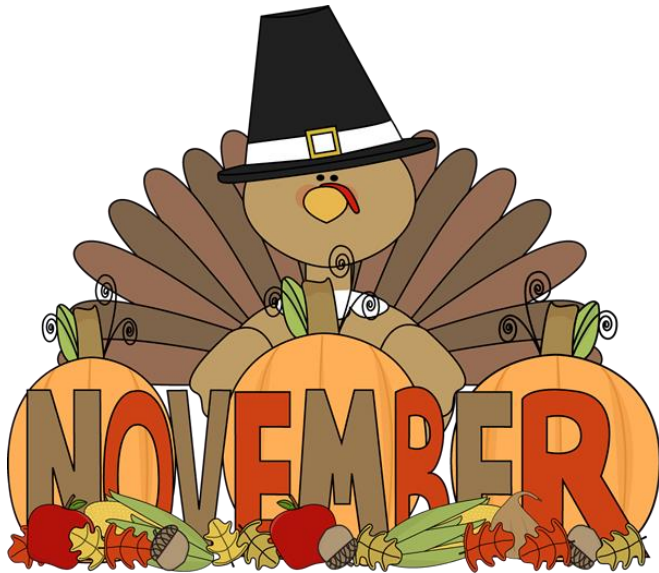

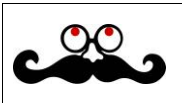

Vice Commodore: Looking to get the four concrete slabs near the door raised. Called five different companies for estimates, with only one responding for \$1,150.00. Board approved estimate not to exceed \$1,500.00.

Commodore: Looking to get vinyl link mats for the doors with the club burgee on it. It would cost \$1,571.00. Board voted in favor to purchase. Pavilion finally has fans, lighting, and electric now for future use. Thanks to Ed and Chris for the work that was done on it. Please get your flyers/articles in on a timely manner.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:22 p.m. with a motion made by Treasurer Moore and seconded by Vice Commodore Malik. Next meeting will be November 12th, 2019 at 7 p.m.
