Gordon is going to fixing the boxes for the bubblers, so money will be saved by him doing that. Brackets are also needed for the bubblers. Please make sure plastic ice bags are not going into the harbor, they are clogging up the bubblers, causing them to break down.

Fleet Captain: Jimmy Buffett weekend is this weekend. 12 boats are reserved. Sip and Dip is at 3 p.m. on Saturday and breakfast is at 10 a.m. on Sunday. Still looking for prizes to donate. Another Fun Run is schedule for September 15th and different destination are being worked on. New koozies have been ordered and are \$3.00 per koozie.

Secretary: Letter was read stating how well the grounds look and thanking the members and the club for allowing Ben George and Haley Piper to have their upcoming wedding at the club.
